## **Volunteer translators (SUMIGRE project)**

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) Project Development and Implementation Unit (PDIU) is seeking seven volunteer translators for the *Supporting professional development of migrant-related educators (SUMIGRE)* project. The positions are unpaid. Translators can work from home or in the IOM Budapest office.

Within the framework of SUMIGRE, a comprehensive education training curriculum has been developed in English in six project countries. The training modules are the following: human rights of migrants and legal instruments; intercultural awareness; intercultural competencies; intercultural communication; discrimination in education; entrepreneurship; and second language teaching in migrant education.

- Translate professionally at least 1 training module (20-30 pages) from English to Hungarian in a template;
- Translate the training module(s) by 12 April 2019;

### **Requirement:**

- Excellent written English and Hungarian required;
- Excellent writing skills;
- Experience in translating migration-related technical texts from English to Hungarian;
- Attention to detail, ability to keep deadlines.

Applicants are expected to be covered by their own medical and accident insurance. Interested applicants should send a CV and a cover letter to IOM Budapest ([iombudapest@iom.int](mailto:iombudapest@iom.int)) by 22 March 2019, then selected candidates will be asked to translate a sample text. Volunteers will be required to sign an internship contract.
