

Volunteering opportunity with IOM Budapest (Hungarian speaking)

The International Organization for Migration (IOM) Project Development and Implementation Unit (PDIU) is seeking two Volunteers for a part-time (cca. 10-15 hours/week), five-month commitment to work in Budapest starting in November 2017. Volunteers will contribute to IOM Budapest's efforts to improve conditions for intercultural dialogue and civic participation.

Responsibilities:

- 1) Assist with the organization of an exhibition about migration, integration and diversity;
- 2) Assist with the collection of materials/items related to Hungary's experience with migration;
- 3) Support procurement processes and correspondence with service providers and sub-contractors;
- 4) Oversee the exhibition and ensure great visitor experience to school groups and other visitors;
- 5) Assist with organization of non-formal learning activities;
- 6) Contribute to IOM's online presence to promote events;
- 7) Participate in a week-long capacity building workshop/activity in Greece with project partners (second half of November or early December 2017);
- 8) Perform any other duties as requested.

Requirements:

- 1) Excellent communication and interpersonal skills required;
- 2) Experience with organizing cultural and/or other events distinct advantage:
- 3) Excellent spoken and written Hungarian and good command of English required;
- 4) A degree in marketing, communications, international relations, sociology, political science or any other relevant field distinct advantage;
- 5) Experience using publication/photo editor software distinct advantage
- 6) Experience and/or proven interest in migration issues distinct advantage;
- 7) Familiarity with non-formal learning advantage;
- 8) Experience with an international organization or an NGO advantage.

Volunteers are expected to be covered by their own medical and accident insurance. Monthly travel passes (for Budapest public transport - BKK) will be provided for successful candidates during their time with IOM Hungary.
